A Brief History of the Program

Since 1985, Wayne State University School of Medicine has had in place an informal MD/PhD program funded entirely by the School of Medicine and Medical Alumni philanthropy. In 2004, Wayne State University created a new MD/PhD program housed in the School of Medicine (SOM), supported in part through medical tuition scholarships, to formalize the training of physician-scientists.

Wayne State University School of Medicine (WSU SOM)

The WSU SOM is comprised of basic & clinical science departments. Located in midtown Detroit, our faculty and students are dedicated to making a measurable impact in communities at home and around the world.

As of 2022, U.S. News and World Report named WSU SOM a Top 100 medical school for research in its annual Best Medical Schools rankings. The magazine ranks the School of Medicine 68th in research of the 188 medical schools eligible for ranking. The school ranks 86th in the category of Best Medical Schools for Primary Care. Other rankings include: 28th Most Diverse Medical School and 58th in Most Graduates Serving in Medically Underserved Areas.


